Rutgers professor Donald Roden founded the [Mountainview Project](#) at Rutgers in 2005, after spending some years tutoring inmates at the Mountainview Youth Correctional Facility in Annandale, N.J. Roden encouraged inmates with the potential to succeed academically to continue their studies at Rutgers after release. To date, Mountainview has enrolled 110 former inmates, 25 have earned bachelor's degrees, and five have received master's degrees. [MORE >>](#)
